Clashing of classes

Whilst every endeavor has been made with the timetable to accommodate everyone, clashing is sometimes unavoidable.

Therefore classes will not be held up – so please bear this in mind when entering, as entry fees are **non refundable**.

This show is a qualifier for the Ponies (UK) 2010 Summer Championship Show, to be held on the 11th – 14th August at the Newark & Nott's Showground. The 1st 2nd & 3rd in each class will qualify. No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.

Competitors in qualifying positions, who are **not** current members of P(UK) are allowed **14 days** in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 1st July and 31st July their membership must be submitted within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 4-6th August 2010.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the final.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the M&M In Hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification Card.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve. Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 4-6th August 2010

All classes will be judged within the rules and criteria of the BSPA (Details from BSPA 01354 638226 or downloaded from www.bsponline.com). **All stallions 4 years and over must be graded licensed and registered with the BSPA in order to compete.** All classes are open to members and non-members but in order to qualify all owners/handlers/riders must be members of the BSPA and all horses/ponies registered with BSPA **prior** to the show. BSPA qualification cards must be produced in the ring and be signed by the judge, otherwise the qualification is invalid. In all WCC Ridden Horse Classes the judge may ride and or request a display. JMB certificates are not required to enter this qualifier.

Judges may only judge one qualifier during the current year and marks will be awarded as follows:

Breed, Type, Conformation	50 Maximum

In the case of equality, the pony with the highest Show, freedom of action mark will be deemed the winner. The highest placed animal (not already qualified) from the first three in the final judging will qualify for the Horse of the Year Show 2010. A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the Mountain & Moorland Ridden section.

To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 4-6th August 2010.

All classes will be judged within the rules and criteria of the BSPA (Details from BSPA 01354 638226 or downloaded from www.bsponline.com). **All stallions 4 years and over must be graded licensed and registered with the BSPA in order to compete.** All classes are open to members and non-members but in order to qualify all owners/handlers/riders must be members of the BSPA and all horses/ponies registered with BSPA **prior** to the show. BSPA qualification cards must be produced in the ring and be signed by the judge, otherwise the qualification is invalid. In all WCC Ridden Horse Classes the judge may ride and or request a display. Qualification 1 – 3 in all classes or 1 – 4 for classes exceeding 12. Exhibitors must not enter the breeding details of any exhibit that does not hold a breed society verified parentage passport. No spurs to be worn by any competitor

Class 45 BSPA Ridden Skewbald and Piebald Plaited Horse or Pony 4 years old and over, any sex or height. Judge will not ride.

Class 46 BSPA Skewbald and Piebald Open Native/Traditional/Vanner Cob, any height or age. Judge will not ride.

Class 47 BSPA Skewbald and Piebald Ridden Novice Horses or Ponies in their first season of competition or never to have won 2 firsts. Any suitable snaffle bridle may be worn. Judge will not ride.

10. All ridden ponies must be 4 years or over.
11. All dogs should be kept on leads whilst on the showground.
12. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14th Birthday before 1st January of the current year.
13. Riders of small breeds stallions (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Sections A & B) must have attained their 11th Birthday before 1st January of the current year. Riders of large breed stallions (Highland, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Sections C & D) must have attained their 14th Birthday before January of the current year.
14. Handlers of ponies in in-hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps/riding hats.
15. All exhibits must be registered in the Stud Book or Register of their respective Breed or Type.
16. Strictly no mucking out onto premises, there will be a £50 fine if you are seen to do this.
17. Please take your litter home with you or use the bins provided.
18. The Show Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
